

GENERAL RULES

- Bay Palms Golf Courses are for the use of active duty/retired military and their family members, reserve components, DoD civilians, and their family members.
- Golfers are expected to check in with the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
- Annual, semi-annual, or daily fees must be paid prior to play on the course. All players are required to register in the pro shop prior to play and have, in their possession, a membership card, or a receipt for the day indicating they have registered/paid the appropriate fees.
- Appropriate golf attire will be worn at all times. The wearing of military uniforms (or parts of) is prohibited (except during active duty clinics). Shirts with collars and sleeves must be worn at all times. The following attire is not authorized: bathing suits, gym shorts, jogging shorts, spandex pants, or any other type of form fitting material, cut-offs (shirt/shorts), men's tank tops, short shorts, halters, mesh see-through garments or any garment that exposes the bare midriff areas.
- Only golf shoes w/soft spikes, flat-soled sneakers, or tennis shoes will be permitted on the course.
- Powered golf carts are limited to two (2) riders. Individuals renting carts must be 16 years or older and have a valid driver's license. Carts will not be driven adjacent to tees and greens except on cart paths. Red-top poles are placed in front of each green to indicate where carts should return to paths.
- Use 90° rule for power carts unless otherwise posted. When carts are permitted on fairways, stay on cart path until parallel your ball, then drive straight to it. After hitting, return to cart path. Be a 90° driver... help protect our fairways.
- All players must have a set of clubs. Rental clubs are available through the Pro Shop.
- Limited locker rental is available on a yearly basis. \$48 a year + \$5 Key Deposit.
- Food and beverages must be purchased at the Bay Palms "Main Course." Coolers are not permitted.
- Refunds will not be made for daily green fees. If the course is closed due to inclement weather, a rain check may be issued by the manager or a designated representative.
- All play will start on the first holes unless permission is granted by the starter or management to do otherwise.
- No walking the South Course prior to 1 pm unless the North Course is closed for maintenance.
- Retrieving golf balls from the lakes is not permitted, except for players attempting to find their own ball during the course of their round.
- The manager or a designated representative has the authority to request anyone to leave the premises for misconduct or cause.
- For safety reasons, children younger than eight are not permitted on the course.
- Youth 8-15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult member unless approved for individual play by the manager. (See Clinics for Junior Clinic times.)

AUTOMATED TEE TIME RESERVATION SYSTEM

Please Use These Guidelines For ALL Tee Time Reservations.

The system is a 3-line rotary set-up providing entry into our clubhouse computer system. After entering the system, you will hear a schedule for the coming week and be instructed to press "1" on your touch-tone phone. You will then be asked to enter your handicap or pin number (this is your membership/handicap number). Non-members use "9999." Your number will be repeated back to you and you will press "1" to confirm or "2" to correct your entry.

You Will Then Reach The Main Menu

- Press "1" to register for a tee time.
- Press "3" to inquire about an existing tee time (any tee times reserved under your membership number)
- To register for a tee time, you will be given the option of: "0" • Either Course "1" • South Course "2" North Course
- Next you will need to enter the number of players in your group • 2, 3 or 4 (you cannot make a tee time for a single golfer)
- You will then be asked to enter the number of the day you want to make a tee time for • for Mar 2nd, enter 2 - for Mar 28th, enter 28.
- The next step is to enter the earliest time you would like • 1:30 pm is 1330 - 8:30 am is 0830. You will then be given the nearest time to what you have requested. To confirm the time press "1." To obtain the next available time, press "2."
- You will then be given a reservation confirmation number. Then you can hang up to end the call

Questions

I think someone else may be using my number to make tee times.

Only the person whose number is used to make the reservation will be allowed to tee off at the selected reservation time.

I have a 10 am tee time but at 9 am an emergency came up and it's too late to notify my playing partners, what happens to them?

A simple phone call to 828-4494, with an explanation of your situation and your group will be allowed to use your tee time without you being present (you are still responsible for getting any civilian guests entry to the base).

I play with the same group every Mon/Wed/Fri, how do we keep from getting four tee times each day?

We would recommend that if each of you are going to call, that you only use one of your numbers. This way, if a tee time has already been made, you will not be allowed to double it up.

A sample of the keypad entry for a tee time for a foursome on either course at 0800 on the 25th of the month would be: 840-6915 • 1 • "your number" • 1 • 1 • 0 • 25 • 0800 • 1

This should take you approximately 1-minute to make a reservation.

When Can I Call For Tee Times?

Priority for tee times begins at 1-second after midnight. Active duty can make reservations up to 7 days in advance; retired members call reserve up to 5 days in advance, and all other eligible golfers can make reservations up to 3 days in advance.

TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Active Duty have priority at all times & may reserve tee times 7 days in advance with "Pin" numbers. Active Duty assigned to MacDill are issued pin numbers at the Pro Shop.

Advanced Green Fee Players may reserve tee times 5 days in advance.

All Other Eligible Golfers may reserve tee times 3 days in advance. Tee Time Reservations are accomplished via an Automated Telephone System. Each golfer must use a "Pin Number" to access the system.

Advance Green Fee Players will use their membership number as a pin number. All other eligible golfers (civilian employees/retirees, etc) will use "9999" as a pin number.

CARE OF THE COURSE

- Please ensure that any turf cut or displaced is repaired at once by filling w/sand.
- Damage to putting greens by ball pitch marks - "always fix yours & one other."
- Rake/smooth down sand in all bunkers & leave rake, teeth down, in the bunker.
- Trash receptacles are provided - please use them. Help keep your course clean!
- Golf bags should not be placed on the greens.
- Pull carts should remain off all tees & at least 10 feet from all greens. Pull carts are not permitted between greens & adjacent bunkers.
