On the medical front, the 6th Medical Group will provide limited ops & healthcare Wed, 13 Sep 17 and return to normal ops Thu, 14 Sep 17. During this time, beneficiaries (local or evacuated) can seek medical care without a referral by contacting any TRICARE authorized provider. While a blanket referral waiver is effective through September 30, 2017, if you are in the local area please seek care at the 6 Medical Group (MacDill and Brandon Clinic) starting Thursday, September 14, 2017. In addition, all beneficiaries can go to the nearest emergency room for emergency medical care. New prescriptions and emergency refills can be filled at any TRICARE authorized pharmacy through September 15, 2017.
