

AIR FORCE YOUTH PROGRAMS REGISTRATION

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

AUTHORITY: Title 10 U.S.C. 8012 and 44 U.S.C. 3101.

PRINCIPLE PURPOSES: To register dependent youth of military, retired and DoD personnel in the Air Force Youth Programs. Providing Youth Programs the authorization for medical treatment in emergency situations; authorization for transportation; record youth/family information; photo use authorization; and releasing of liability.

ROUTINE USES: This form may be disclosed to any DoD component or part thereof, and upon request to other Federal, State and local government agencies in the pursuit of their official duties; disclosed to news media; used for other lawful purposes including law enforcement and litigation.

DISCLOSURE IS VOLUNTARY: Failure to provide the information may preclude the individual from participation in Air Force sponsored youth programs.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENTS

MEDICAL CARE AUTHORIZATION: I hereby authorize my child to receive emergency medical treatment whenever it is deemed necessary at any U.S. Military Facility or any other medical facility when a U.S. Military Medical Facility is not available.

SPORT:

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION: Registration consists of the AF IMT 88, MacDill AFB Youth Sports Registration Form, current school/sports physical (good thru the end of the season), signed Parents' Pledge, proof of a current flu shot. These documents must be submitted at the time of registration. Children will not be placed on teams until the required registration documents are complete. Youth Sports must be informed of any medical conditions that require special treatment or attention.

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be given for PCS or medical reasons. Documentation must be provided. If an age group is cancelled, fees will be refunded no later than 10 days after the start of the season. After the 10 day period, fees can only be applied to a future sport or sports camp.

Returned Check Charge: A charge of \$25.00 for any returned check will be added to the fees and the player is ineligible to participate in any Youth Program until restitution has been made.

Equipment: Players must provide their own safety items (mouth guard, shin guard, shoes, etc) and the equipment will be inspected by the Sports Director to make sure Air Force requirements are met.

No pets will be permitted at any youth sports event or facility
