Did You Know?

DoDI 1338.10, Department of Defense Food Service Program (DFSP) states, Enlisted Service members are entitled to a ration for each day on active duty, except when they are entitled to a basic allowance for subsistence (BAS) or per diem.

What Do You Get?

Authorized 3 meals per day at the Diner's Reef (DFAC)

OR

a Campus Dining Facility

(Seascapes Beach House, Surf's Edge Club,
Fairways Grill (Golf Course) or Ten Pin Grill (Bowling Center))

*A meal is considered a reasonable amount of food that can typically be consumed in one sitting (sit down or grab-n-go)

Benefits DO NOT Include

- Procure meal/snack items to "stock" an individuals' dorm room or work center
- Use their ESM privilege to provide meals/snacks/beverages to others
- Receive more than one (1) entrée serving (i.e. 1 steak, 1 sandwich or 1 pasta dish per transaction through cashier
 - ESM members are authorized seconds as additional points of sale (POS) transaction for dine in only
- Use carryout meals as second meal in the same meal period
- Receive more than two (2) beverages and two (2) snack items (chips, cookies, and convenience sundry items) per meal period
- Use their ESM privilege in the Army & Exchange Service (AAFES)
- Use their ESM privilege to purchase alcoholic beverages, energy drinks (Red Bull, Monster, etc.), or dietary supplements (Muscle Milk, protein shakes, etc.)
